

#### **Market Commentary**

The Trinidad and Tobago Treasury Yield Curve remained relatively stable over the one-month period December 2018 to January 2019. The 10-year Treasury Yield was constant for the period December 2018 to January 2019 at 4.42%. Commercial banks' excess reserves continued to increase, rising modestly from TT\$3.37 billion in November 2018 to TT\$3.50 billion in December 2018.

Inflation remained contained, with headline inflation and food inflation increasing over the period November 2018 to December 2018, from 1.0% to 1.1% and -0.2% to 0.0% respectively. Core inflation remained at 1.3% over the same period November 2018 to December 2018.




