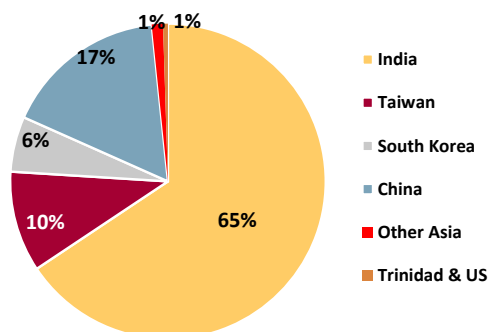

Total Net Asset Value as at September 30, 2025

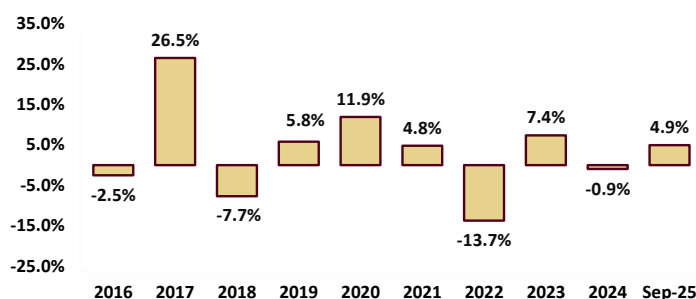

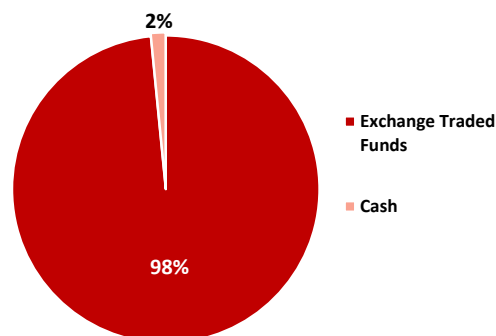
